

9th & 10th Commandments

Memory Worksheet

Goal: Understanding the central teachings of the church .

Students & parents are responsible for assigned memory work. This memory worksheet includes family discussion questions. You are to recite these verses and discuss the questions with a parent. Once your parent is satisfied with your efforts, your parent must sign the worksheet to indicate completion of the assignment. Memory Worksheets are due the week after they were handed out.

Memory Work:

*Your memory work is the 9th & 10th commandments with explanation.*

The 9th Commandment: **“You shall not covet your neighbor’s house”**

What does this mean? **We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor’s inheritance or house, or get it in a way which only appears right, but help and be of service to him in keeping it.**

The 10th Commandment: **“You shall not covet your neighbor’s wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.**

What does this mean? **We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor’s wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.**

Discussion Question:

- What does it mean to covet something?
- At what point does desiring something cross the line from coveting to stealing?
- Why is God interested in your thoughts?
