

6th Commandment
Memory Worksheet

Goal: Understanding the central teachings of the church .

Students & parents are responsible for assigned memory work. This memory worksheet includes family discussion questions. You are to recite this commandment with explanation and discuss the questions with a parent. Once your parent is satisfied with your efforts, your parent must sign the worksheet to indicate completion of the assignment. Memory Worksheets are due the week after they were handed out.

Memory Work:

Your memory work is the 6h commandments with explanation.

The 6th Commandment: **“You shall not commit adultery.”**

What does this mean? **We should fear and love God so that we lead a sexually pure and decent life in what we say and do, and husband and wife love and honor each other.**

Discussion Question:

- Most adolescents who are not sexually active (meaning not having sexual intercourse) are nonetheless sexually intimate. Define what sex is and what it is not. For example, is holding hands sex? What form of touching would you consider sex?

- Where do you draw the line? Where does your parents draw the line? Do you agree? Why or why not?

- What are your parents values and beliefs concerning premarital sex?

- How is pornography addressed by this commandment?
