

Memory Worksheet

Goal: Understanding the central teachings of the church .

Students & parents are responsible for assigned memory work. This memory worksheet includes family discussion questions. You are to recite these verses and discuss the questions to a parent. Once your parent is satisfied with your efforts, your parent must sign the worksheet to indicate completion of the assignment. Memory Worksheets are due the week after they were handed out.

Memory Work:

Your Memory work is about the 2nd Article of the Apostles Creed. We say this in church almost every Sunday so you do not need to memorize this part:

And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.

You are asked to memorize the explanation which follows:

What does this mean? I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten of the Father from eternity, and also true man, born of the Virgin Mary, is my Lord,
who has redeemed me, a lost and condemned person, purchased and won me from all sins, from death, and from the power of the devil; not with gold or silver, but with His holy, precious blood and with His innocent suffering and death,
that I may be His own and live under Him in His kingdom and serve Him in everlasting righteousness, innocence, and blessedness,
just as He is risen from the dead, lives and reigns to all eternity.
This is most certainly true.

Discussion Question:

You do need to provide written answers to these questions. Your only requirement is to discuss the questions with a parent. However, if you want to write a response I would welcome it.

- Is there a way to distinguish between the nature of man and the nature of God in Jesus?
- Can you separate the man from the God in Jesus Christ? Explain.
