

The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?


- When evildoers assail me to eat up my flesh, my adversaries and foes, it is they who stumble and fall.



For those gathered with us in-person, an offering plate will be at the back of the room for a contactless drop-off for your gifts, tithes, and offerings as you leave today's service.




